ACTS is a system which regulates students in credit-earning and credit-transfer process based on learning outcomes and learning process explained in the content of curriculum. It aims to facilitate planning, implementation, assessment, recognition, and validation of the qualification, learning unit, and student mobility.

Study load describes the time needed by students to finish a learning



activities (such as in class meetings, seminars, practical work, independent activity, examinations, etc.) needed to achieve the targeted learning outcomes. In comparison, European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) describe study load of one academic year related to its learning outcomes. In most ECTS cases, study load of each student ranges from 1500 to 1800 hours for one academic year. While in ACTS, study load of each student ranges from 1152 to 2304 hours for one academic year (12 to 24 ACTS per semester). Thus an ECTS is equal to 25-30 hours while an ACTS is equal to 48 hours.
