<b>About the University</b>	<p>Jawaharlal Nehru University is the foremost university in India, and a world-renowned centre for teaching and research. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) accredited JNU A++ Grade (highest grade by NAAC) in 2018. JNU also received the Best University Award from the President of India in 2017.</p> <p>came into existence in 1969 the approach of the University has been to evolve policies and programmes which will make Jawaharlal Nehru University a distinct addition to the national resources in higher education rather than a mere quantitative expansion of facilities which already exist. The University has identified and is concentrating upon some major academic programmes, which are of relevance to national progress and development.</p> <p>The basic academic units of the University are not single discipline departments but multi-disciplinary Schools of Studies. Some Schools are made up of a number of Centres which constitute the units operating within the broad framework of a School. A Centre has been defined as a community of scholars irrespective of their disciplines engaged in clearly identified inter-disciplinary programmes of research and teaching.
