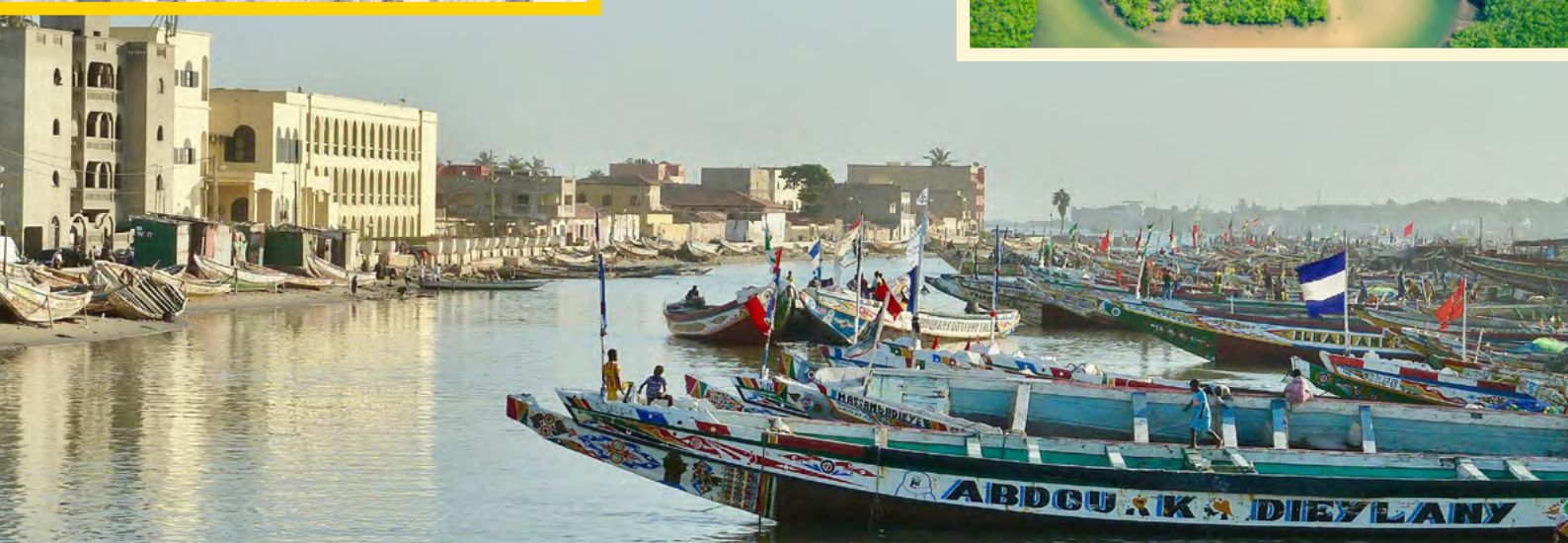

3. Official Academic Transcript –with university logo and stamp		
4. Health Insurance Certificate - You can submit to a monthly insurance with local insurance companies

Required academic level

- SUPDECO Bachelor 2nd year: Minimum 1 year of completed studies
- SUPDECO Bachelor 3rd year / BBA Program: Minimum 2 years of Completed studies
- Bachelor in International Business 3rd year: Minimum 2 years of Completed studies
- Master of Science – 1st Year: Minimum 3 years of completed studies
- Master of Science – 2nd Year: Minimum 4 years of completed studies
- Bachelor in Foreign Languages Applied to Management

For international students (except for European Community, Americans and Canadians), please kindly confirm with the immigration service of your home country whether your country is under the category of visa exemption to enter Senegal before your departure. The validity of passport must be at least 6 months from the date of return.

There is a cafeteria where you can get Senegalese foods or other international foods (1 or 2 Euro for lunch)

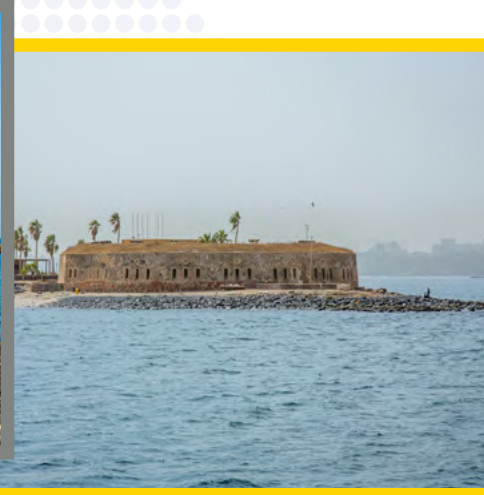
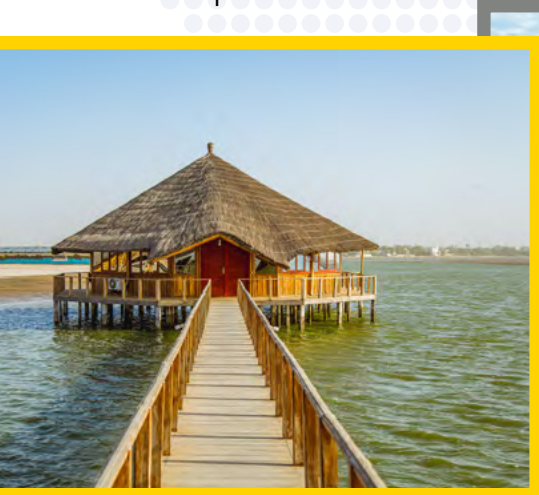
Student Union (BDE) And Teranga International Club (TIC)
